

OVERSEAS MOTORCYCLE LICENCE CONVERSION

To be issued with a full Victorian Motorcycle Licence you must meet the following criteria and requirements:

Is your Overseas Licence from a Recognised County?

Austria, Belgium, Canada, Croatia, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Guernsey, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Ireland, Isle of Man (1), Italy, Japan, Jersey, Luxembourg, Malta (2), Netherlands (Holland), Norway, Portugal, Singapore, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, UK and USA

(1) for licences first issued on or after 1 April 1991

(2) for licences first issued on or after 2 Jan 2004

(3) licences from Ontario Canada must be surrendered and returned to the licensing authority

You must complete all training and assessments required in Victoria to be issued a Victorian Licence. None of the standard waiting periods apply.

Do you hold a Victorian car licence?

You must attend a VicRoads office and present your Overseas Licence prior to booking your HART course. You must complete the Two Day Learner Permit course and the Licence Assessment.

You must attend a VicRoads office and present your Overseas Licence and complete a Knowledge Test based on "The Novice Driver Kit" for road laws (KT2) and the Hazard Perception Test at a Vic Roads office. You must also complete the Two day Learner Permit course and the Licence Assessment.

If you hold a full Motorcycle Licence from one of the above-mentioned Countries, you are not required to undertake any tests, provided your Overseas Licence is current or has not expired by more than five years. However, you will be required to make an appointment with VicRoads to change over your Licence.

Complete a Two Day Learner Permit Course

Please note: for the assessment components of the Learner Permit, a VicRoads interpreter can be booked free of charge, Monday to Friday only. For the non-testing components of the Learner Permit a family member or friend is welcome to assist with interpreting.
